




Gangloff Industries, Inc. – NO HAZMAT POLICY

Gangloff Industries, Inc. is not registered as a hazmat carrier on our form MCS-150 on file with FMCSA. Gangloff Industries, Inc. does not require its drivers to have or maintain a Hazardous Material Endorsement on their Commercial Driver's License. The company does not provide hazmat training to our drivers as part of the orientation process, or as part of any training process required by the FMCSA. Drivers are not trained in label recognition, loading requirements, placarding compliance or incident response. The company does not provide or require drivers to carry safety equipment or absorbent materials used to address a hazmat incident. Gangloff Industries, Inc. does not issue to or require its drivers to carry Emergency Response Guides.

Department of Transportation Regulations makes Gangloff Industries, Inc. and its drivers ultimately responsible for the safe transportation of any quantity of hazmat. Any violations of hazmat regulations can subject the company to penalties, including fines and points against both the company's and our drivers' CSA scores.

For these reasons Gangloff Industries, Inc. does not knowingly accept and will not transport shipments containing any quantity of Hazardous material regulated by CFR Title 49, Parts 100-185. This includes shipments containing less than 1000 lbs. of Hazmat which are exempt from placarding requirements.

Gangloff Refrigerated trailers are always considered food grade and never compromised.
